The TASK 50 is the product of extensive R&D carried out jointly by teams of Spanish and Germany design engineers, the priority being to enable the vehicle to perform an array of functions with the help of readily attachable accessories. The vehicle is equipped with several strategically located hitching points on front and back, as well as an electro-hydraulic powerpack. Users can choose from several different type tyres - including those designed for working on grass, asphalt or rough terrain. The operator can switch from 4x4 to conventional drive whenever necessary.

The TASK 50 is equipped with a 400cc one-cylinder, 4-stroke, 29 hp engine. The automatic shift has slow, drive, idle and reverse functions, along with a parking gear that locks the vehicle in place by immobilising its four wheels.
