



## THE AUSA D 150 RMA CLEANS THE STREETS OF THE CAPITAL OF ANGOLA

### Background

The Luanda Cleaning and Sanitation Company (ELISAL) is responsible for cleaning certain areas of the city and also for the management of contracts awarded to private companies for the cleaning of other areas. Because refuse is collected using a broom and shovel and then deposited directly without the use of bags, workers require machinery in which to place the rubbish. Public company ELISAL needs to provide suitable machines to facilitate this work.

In Luanda, the capital of Angola, refuse collection is very much in the news. A few months ago, the government issued a statement regarding the need to improve such services as a health and safety measure to protect citizens. It is therefore of vital importance that companies responsible for providing these services are equipped with machinery that guarantees efficient waste management.

### AUSA commercial solution

The AUSA D 150 RMA dumper is ideal for refuse collection. Its features are perfect for the requirements of the cleaning company of the Angolan capital because its hopper has a higher reach than other models, giving it the elevation needed to tip the refuse into the tractor trailer where it is deposited.

In Luanda and other cities of similar characteristics, it is vital that the size of machinery allows for ease of movement in urban environments, where streets are often very narrow. The compact dimensions and excellent handling of the D 150 RMA facilitate the work of operators.

## D 150 RMA: manoeuvrable and efficient

AUSA dumpers are very robust and adapt to all terrains. Their compact design enables them to carry out a wide range of tasks and facilitates the work of excavators and other machines in areas inaccessible for such machinery.

Moreover, they are designed to the most demanding technological standards in order to guarantee excellent efficiency.

Safety is another of the strengths of these machines and, depending on the model, they can come equipped with sealed oil-immersed brakes, emergency brakes, low-emission engines, anti-vandal systems, ROPS, seat belts, horns, amongst other options. Operator comfort is also an AUSA priority. For this reason, the visibility from these machines is perfect, thereby avoiding driver fatigue and possible mishaps.

The D 150 RMA has a rigid chassis, a load capacity of some 1,500 kg, mechanical transmission and high tipping. It is ideal for refuse collection due to its dimensions, hopper reach, low maintenance costs and ease of use. Both the 4x2 and 4x4 models facilitate handling on all terrains, highlighting the versatility so characteristic of these vehicles.



### The work to be done

The D 150 RMA is used for street cleaning in the suburbs of the metropolitan area of Luanda.

The work is done as follows: workers sweep the streets with brooms and shovels and then deposit the refuse in the hopper of the dumper. The D 150 RMA then tips this waste into trailers towed by tractors.
