



## The Taurulift T 204 H, an ideal telescopic forklift for the agricultural sector, is chosen for work on a Polish farm

### Background

Rafat Grodziski is the owner of a chicken farm in the Polish town of Góra, situated in the district of Inowrocław. For his work on the farm, Mr Grodziski required a machine for loading and unloading that would be sufficiently compact to allow access to the chicken coops. Mr Grodziski first saw the AUSA Taurulift T 204 H telescopic forklift at the "Green Agro Show". AUSA's extensive distribution network facilitated contact with a distributor in his area and after testing the vehicle and experiencing its high-quality features, he decided to purchase one.

### The AUSA solution

Thanks to its compact design and configuration, the Taurulift T 204 H is the perfect machine for Mr Grodziski's chicken farm. Its size is ideal for access to the chicken coops and the client is also delighted with its power and payload. Excellent manoeuvrability, added to a lower turning radius with 4x4 traction gives the Taurulift T 204 H optimal handling. The position of the cabin at the front means that the T 204 H offers unbeatable visibility.

Thanks to the Multi-Tach system, it is an exceptionally versatile machine that can incorporate any of the implements used in mini-loaders. These and other features have led to the enormous success of the AUSA Taurulift T 204 H in northern European countries. The fact that it boasts the same features and greater manoeuvrability at a lower cost than comparable machines has made the Taurulift T 204 H tremendously successful in the agricultural sector.

### The work at hand

The main task of the Taurulift T 204 H is to take the manure from the coops to the trucks subsequent to the incubation period of the eggs. Apart from loading and unloading, the Taurulift T 204 H is also used for grain mixing, another of the activities carried out on Mr Grodziski's farm.



## Taurulift T 204 H: Maximum payload and excellent manoeuvrability

The Taurulift T 204 H is a compact four-wheel-drive forklift with an extendable arm, folding cabin and hydrostatic transmission. It comes with a latest-generation Kubota 50-HP engine, certified to EPA Tier 4 standards.

It has a maximum payload of 2,000 kg, at a height of 4.2 metres (the highest on the market in its class). At full load, it can negotiate inclines of up to 45%, thanks to its four-wheel drive and raised chassis (340 mm in height).

Its dimensions and small turning radius make it ideal for working in tight spaces or areas of difficult access (1.6 m wide and cabin height of less than 2 metres)

This machine provides an optimum combination of the AUSA mast forklift and the extendable arm. The AUSA mast forklift offers optimum ergonomics, robustness, all-terrain capability, intuitive handling and safety. In addition, the front-folding cabin (which allows easy access to engine parts) facilitates maintenance.

The extendable arm offers a variable-reach fork function and a lower turning radius, thanks to the 4x4x4 traction and steering system.



Grodziski added that, **“this is one of the great advantages of the T 204 H”, with respect to small articulated loaders.**
